## **ABSTRACT**

This file provides a template for writing papers for the conference. The conference proceedings will be published in an electronic format. The manuscript in MS Word file or LaTeX shall be written in compliance with these instructions.

## **1 INTRODUCTION**

It is expected that the authors will submit carefully written and proofread material. Spelling and grammatical errors, as well as language usage problems, are not acceptable. The authors should limit their papers to 8 pages, presenting their results as concisely as possible.

## **2 PAPER FORMAT**

The uniform outlook will help the reader to follow the proceedings. This can be obtained most easily if the authors use this template file to construct their manuscripts. Please note the following details: this template is an A4 format with 25 mm margins on the left, right, top and bottom.

All text paragraphs should be single spaced; with the first line indented for 10 mm. The position and style of headings and subheadings should follow this example. No spaces should be placed between paragraphs or headings and paragraphs. All format styles are predefined (all have names starting with S, following a two digit number) and available in the menu Styles.

### **2.1 Header, Footer, Page Numbering**

If this template is used when writing the manuscript, the headers and footers will be set automatically. The authors are only asked to replace the “NNN” with their 3-digit paper number on the footer of the first page and on the header of other pages in order to set a unique page number in the Proceedings. The paper number is written on your letter of acceptance or can be obtained from the web site of the conference [www.nss.si/nene2014](http://www.nss.si/nene2014) in the Conference Program section.

## 2.2 Fonts

The papers should use 12-point Times New Roman or equivalent. Times, Symbol or Arial fonts can be used in figures. It is recommended that the text in figures is not smaller than 10-point font size. The authors are discouraged from using other fonts.

## 2.3 Figures and Tables

The figure captions and table headings should be sufficient to explain the figure or table without needing to refer to the text. Figures and tables not cited in the text should not be presented.

The tables and figures should be placed close after the paragraph of their first mentioning. All figures and tables shall be numbered with Arabic numerals. The table headings shall be centred above the tables. The figure captions should be centred below the figures.

Please use “In Line with Text” text wrapping for figures. In Word 2007 and Word 2010, click the image. Click the Picture Tools Formatting tab. In the Text Wrapping menu choose In line with Text.

## 2.4 Equations

Each equation should be presented on a separate line with a blank space above and below. The equations should be numbered consecutively at the outer right margin, as shown in Eq. (1) below.

$$\Delta\rho = 1.5\% \times \Delta k/k \tag{1}$$

## 2.5 References

Reference numbers in the text should be designated by square brackets, e.g., [1]. The references should be listed in the same order as cited in the text. For referring on the reference, click in the

text where the reference number will be inserted. Chose Insert> Cross-reference> chose Reference type> Numbered item> go to chapter “References”> Insert reference to (“Paragraph number (no context)”) and chose the desired reference. Some examples of how to list references are given in the Section References.

### 3 SUBMITTING THE MANUSCRIPT

The LaTeX manuscripts should be submitted as a PDF file electronically through the conference website [www.nss.si/nene2014](http://www.nss.si/nene2014) (not by e-mail) before August 31, 2014. The same account as used for the submittal of the abstract should be used for the submission of the paper. Please login and upload the paper in the My Abstracts and Papers tab.
